





The Congested Area Plan (CAP) submitted to our office on June 4, 2019 has been approved.

This approval is limited to the proposed operations for the replacement of (utility poles) located at or near 32231 Trabuco Creek Rd in Trabuco Canyon, Ca. The approved date of operation is schedule to commence on June 10, 2019 and will cease on June 22, 2019, between the hours of 0700 and 1800 in a secure area, as defined in the CAP.

The secure area must be strictly, maintained with only the personnel and vehicles that are directly involved with the lift operations, in the secured area. Failure to maintain a secure operational area will be grounds for cancellation of this operation.

Particular attention must be paid to clearing any debris in the attachment area and securing work materials that may be disturbed by helicopter rotor wash.

This approval is contingent upon any authorization and/or permits required by State of California or local authorities. Inspectors from this office may monitor the operation to ensure compliance with the approved plan.

Subject: Uncongested external load operation

We are submitting the attached external load lift plan for notification purposes only.

Background:

On June 10, 2019 between the hours of 7:00 AM to 6:00PM Southern California Edison will be replacing 17 deteriorated utility poles on Santiago Peak in Trabuco Canyon, Ca.

Location

The project location: 32231 Trabuco Creek Rd. Trabuco Canyon, Ca. 92679 LZ Lat/Long: 33° 40.138'N, 117° 34.211'W

Issues requiring mitigation and action taken:

- 1. The LZ is on private property1,050 feet from Trabuco Creek Rd and is controlled through a gate which will be closed off to the non-participating public.
- The pilot will monitor all access roads and trails ensuring the non-participating public does not enter the operating area maintaining a 300 foot safety clearance during all external load operations.
- 3. All affected dirt areas will be watered down prior to the arrival of the helicopter, and kept watered during the lift operation if conditions warrant.
- 4. Forced Landing area, (emergency Landing area) exists at the LZ, set site and along the flight path.
- 5. Orange County Sheriffs will be notified.
- 6. Orange County Fire Department will be notified.



Site Plan - Detail




