Dear Mr. Teubner:

The enclosed Congested Area Plan (CAP) submitted to this office on July 23, 2019, has been approved and is returned for your disposition.

This approval is limited to the proposed operations (Edison pole replacement) along 677 Deodar Lane, Bradbury, California, July 30th 2019, between the hours of sunrise and sunset. The secure area, defined in the CAP, must be strictly maintained, with only persons and vehicles directly involved with the lift operation in the secured area. Structures within and immediately adjacent to the operational area shall be unoccupied. Particular attention must be paid to clearing any debris in the attachment area and securing work materials that may be disturbed by helicopter rotor wash. Failure to maintain an absolutely secure operational area shall be cause for cancelling the lift.

This approval is contingent upon any authorizations and/or permits required by the State of California or local authorities. Inspectors from this office may monitor the operation to ensure compliance with the approved plan. - Close all doors and windows to prevent dust from entering your home
- If possible, ensure your animals are secure or clear of the area.
