DURING THE LIFT EVOLUTION THE AIRCRAFT AND GROUND CREW WILL ALL BE IN RADIO COMMUNICATIONS. IN THE EVENT OF LOSS COMMUNICATIONS, THE CREW WILL USE STANDARD HAND SIGNALS TO COMMUNICATE WITH THE PILOT. WHEN THE PILOT IS CLEAR HE WILL MOVE THE AIRCRAFT TO A SAFE LOCATION TO ALLOW THE COMMUNICATION PROBLEM TO BE RECTIFIED.

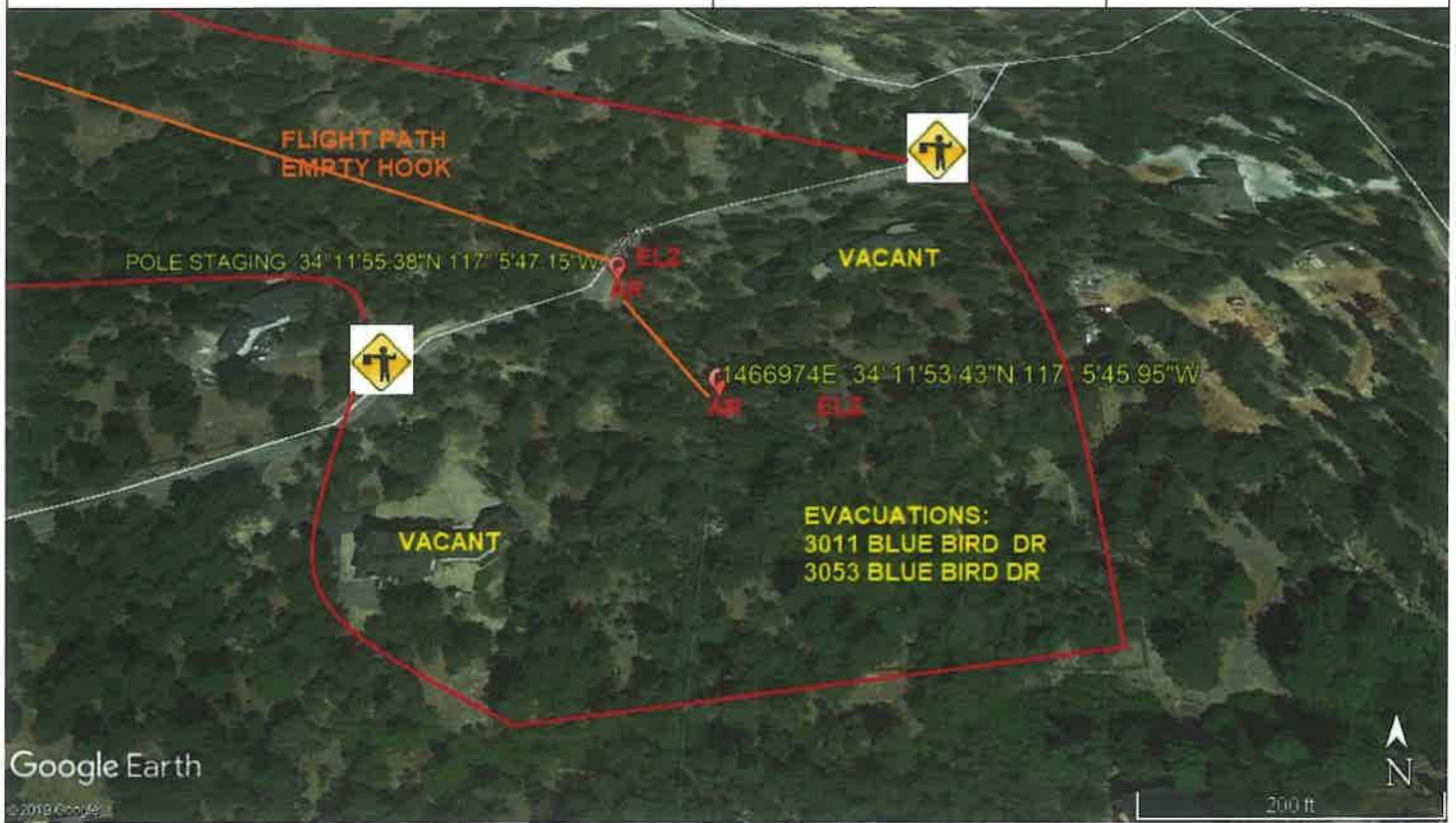

Structures within and immediately adjacent to the operational area shall be unoccupied. Failure to maintain a secure operational area shall be cause for cancelling the lift.

Particular attention must be paid to clearing any debris in the attachment area and securing work materials that may be disturbed by helicopter rotor wash.
