IN THE EVENT AN UNAUTHORIZED PERSON ENTERS THE OPERATIONS AREA OR A POTENTIAL HAZARD IS IDENTIFIED THE PILOT WILL HOLD THE AIRCRAFT IN RELATIVE POSITION. THIS WILL BE ACHIEVED WITHOUT OVER FLYING THE GROUND CREW. ALL OPERATIONS WILL BE CEASED UNTIL THE PROBLEM IS RECTIFIED. IN THE EVENT OF AN AIRCRAFT EMERGENCY, THE PILOT WILL RADIO GROUND PERSONNEL AND WILL ATTEMPT TO LAND IN THE EMERGENCY LANDING AREA.

DURING THE LIFT EVOLUTION THE AIRCRAFT AND GROUND CREW WILL ALL BE IN RADIO COMMUNICATIONS. IN THE EVENT OF LOSS COMMUNICATIONS, THE CREW WILL USE STANDARD HAND SIGNALS TO COMMUNICATE WITH THE PILOT. WHEN THE PILOT IS CLEAR HE WILL MOVE THE AIRCRAFT TO A SAFE LOCATION TO ALLOW THE COMMUNICATION PROBLEM TO BE RECTIFIED.


THE OPERATIONS AREA IS WITHIN THE SECURED AREA. ALL ESSENTIAL CREW WITHIN THE OPERATIONS AREA WILL NOT BE INVOLVED IN TAKING PICTURES OR ANY OTHER USE OF CELL PHONES.

PRIOR TO BEGINNING OPERATIONS, A TAILBOARD SAFETY BRIEF WILL BE CONDUCTED.

- 1. HELICOPTER WILL LAND AT THE MOUNT WILSON TO CONDUCT A HEC TRAINING AND SAFETY TAILBOARD
- 2. FUELING WILL BE CONDUCTED AT THE LANDING ZONE
- 3. EMERGENCY LANDING ZONE IS AT THE STAGING AREA AND ALONG THE FLIGHT PATH
- 4. HEC AND EQUIPMENT WILL BE LIFTED FROM THE LANDING ZONE
- 5. NO STREET CLOSURES
- 6. NO WATER TRUCK
- 7. CUSTOMER WILL PROVIDE CROWD CONTROL AT THE LANDING ZONE
- 8. NO HOME EVACUATIONS
- 9. THE CONTRACTOR WILL TRIM TREES IF REQUIRED









<u>DIRECTIONS:</u> From the 210 freeway, follow the Angeles Crest Highway (State Highway 2) north out of La Canada-Flintridge, past the Angeles Forest Highway turnoff to Palmdale, to the Mount Wilson turnoff at Red Box. This is about 14 miles from the 210 Freeway. Drive about 5 miles more to Mount Wilson. You will arrive at a small intersection near a number of transmitter towers. Follow the "Observatory" sign on the one-way road to the far right around the towers until you reach the Forest Service gate, which is the entrance to Skyline Park and the Observatory.
