ONLY PERSONNEL ESSENTIAL TO COMPLETING THE JOB SAFELY WILL BE PERMITTED TO PARTICIPATE IN THE EVOLUTION. ONLY PERSONNEL PARTICIPATING IN THE SAFETY BRIEF WILL BE PERMITTED TO BE IN THE AREA OF OPERATIONS. ONLY AUTHORIZED ESSENTIAL PERSONAL WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE IMMEDIATE AREA OF OPERATIONS. IN THE EVENT AN UNAUTHORIZED PERSON ENTERS THE OPERATIONS AREA OR A POTENTIAL HAZARD IS IDENTIFIED THE PILOT WILL HOLD THE AIRCRAFT IN RELATIVE POSITION. THIS WILL BE ACHIEVED WITHOUT OVER FLYING THE GROUND CREW. ALL OPERATIONS WILL BE CEASED UNTIL THE PROBLEM IS RECTIFIED. IN THE EVENT OF AN AIRCRAFT EMERGENCY, THE PILOT WILL RADIO GROUND PERSONNEL AND WILL ATTEMPT TO LAND IN THE EMERGENCY LANDING AREA.

DURING THE LIFT EVOLUTION THE AIRCRAFT AND GROUND CREW WILL ALL BE IN RADIO COMMUNICATIONS. IN THE EVENT OF LOSS COMMUNICATIONS, THE CREW WILL USE STANDARD HAND SIGNALS TO COMMUNICATE WITH THE PILOT. WHEN THE PILOT IS CLEAR HE WILL MOVE THE AIRCRAFT TO A SAFE LOCATION TO ALLOW THE COMMUNICATION PROBLEM TO BE RECTIFIED.

THE OPERATIONS AREA IS WITHIN THE SECURED AREA. ALL ESSENTIAL CREW WITHIN THE OPERATIONS AREA WILL NOT BE INVOLVED IN TAKING PICTURES OR ANY OTHER USE OF CELL PHONES.

PRIOR TO BEGINNING OPERATIONS, A TAILBOARD SAFETY BRIEF WILL BE CONDUCTED.


- HELICOPTER WILL LAND AT THE LZ TO CONNECT THE LONGLINE AND CONDUCT A TAILBOARD SAFETY MEETING THE LZ STAGING AREAS IS TO THE EAST OF THE 5 FWY TRUCK ROUTE
- 2. WATER TRUCK IS REQUIRED AT THE LANDING ZONE
- 3. FUELING WILL BE CONDUCTED AT THE LANDING ZONE
- 4. THE HELICOPTER WILL FLY HUMAN EXTERNAL CARGO, AND EQUIPMENT FROM THE EQUIPMENT STAGING AREA TO THE BASE OF STRUCTURE M 8-T7. WHEN CUSTOMER READY THE HELICOPTER WILL PULL ROPE FROM FOOTHILL BLVD TO THE STRUCTURE
- 5. EMERGENCY LANDING ZONE IS AT THE STAGING AREA AND ALONG THE FLIGHT PATH
- 6. FOOTHILL, INTERSTATE 5 TRUCK ROUTE NORTH AND SOUTH WILL BE CLOSED DURING OPERATIONS.
- 7. CUSTOMER WILL HAVE INTERSTATE 5 AND 14 NORTH AND SOUTH CLOSED
- 8. NO STRUCTURES WITHIN THE OPERATING AREA
- 9. FOR HELICOPTER OPERATIONS ALL ACTIVITIES WILL REMAIN TO THE EAST OF THE HWY. THE HWY WILL BE CLOSED FOR LINEMAN OPERATIONS.


THE HELICOPTER WILL LAND AT THE LANDING ZONE OFF OF MIL POTRERO HWY. CONDUCT A TAILBOARD AT THE POLE STAGING AREA OFF OF NADELHORN PL. WHEN THE LINEMAN ARE READY THE STREET CLOSURE AND GROUND CREWMEMBERS WILL KNOCK ON THE DOOR TO ENSURE THEY ARE VACANT. ONCE CLEAR THE STREET CLOSURE TEAM WILL ENSURE THE STREETS AREA CLOSED PER THE DRAWING. THE HELICOPTER WILL FLY TOOLS TO THE POLE SITE IF REQUIRED, THEN SET THE NEW POLE AND REMOVE THE OLD POLE. THE OLD POLE WILL BE PLACED AT THE POLE STAGING AREA. ONCE THE HELICOPTER IS COMPLETE THE STREETS AND HOMES WILL BE REOPENED.

It is important to us that our activity presents as little inconvenience to you as possible.
