Dear Mr. Teubner:

The Congested Area Plan (CAP) originally submitted to this office on July 5, 2018 is approved as amended.

This approval is limited to the proposed operations at 5990 N Cajon Blvd in San Bernardino, California, on July 11, 2020, between sunrise and sunset. Use of the Restricted Category UH-1H helicopters referenced is permitted provided each is flown to and from the job site over the route submitted in your CAP. Restricted Category Helicopters may not be operated over densely populated areas, on a congested airway, or near airports conducting passenger transport operations unless expressly approved. The secure area, defined in the CAP, must be strictly maintained, with only persons and vehicles directly involved with the lift operation in the secured area.

Structures within and immediately adjacent to the operational area shall be unoccupied. Failure to maintain a secure operational area shall be cause for canceling the lift. Particular attention must be paid to clearing any debris in the attachment area and securing work materials that may be disturbed by helicopter rotor wash.

This approval is contingent upon any authorizations and/or permits required by the State of California and local municipal authorities. Inspectors from this office may monitor the operation to ensure compliance with the approved plan. ONLY PERSONNEL PARTICIPATING IN THE SAFETY BRIEF WILL BE PERMITTED TO BE IN THE AREA OF OPERATIONS. ONLY AUTHORIZED ESSENTIAL PERSONAL WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE IMMEDIATE AREA OF OPERATIONS. IN THE EVENT AN UNAUTHORIZED PERSON ENTERS THE OPERATIONS AREA OR A POTENTIAL

HAZARD IS IDENTIFIED THE PILOT WILL HOLD THE AIRCRAFT IN RELATIVE POSITION. THIS WILL BE ACHIEVED WITHOUT OVER FLYING THE GROUND CREW. ALL OPERATIONS WILL BE CEASED UNTIL THE PROBLEM IS RECTIFIED. IN THE EVENT OF AN AIRCRAFT EMERGENCY, THE PILOT WILL RADIO GROUND PERSONNEL AND WILL ATTEMPT TO LAND IN THE EMERGENCY LANDING AREA.

DURING THE LIFT EVOLUTION THE AIRCRAFT AND GROUND CREW WILL ALL BE IN RADIO COMMUNICATIONS. IN THE EVENT OF LOSS COMMUNICATIONS, THE CREW WILL USE STANDARD HAND SIGNALS TO COMMUNICATE WITH THE PILOT. WHEN THE PILOT IS CLEAR HE WILL MOVE THE AIRCRAFT TO A SAFE LOCATION TO ALLOW THE COMMUNICATION PROBLEM TO BE RECTIFIED.

THE OPERATIONS AREA IS WITHIN THE SECURED AREA. ALL ESSENTIAL CREW WITHIN THE OPERATIONS AREA WILL NOT BE INVOLVED IN TAKING PICTURES OR ANY OTHER USE OF CELL PHONES.

PRIOR TO BEGINNING OPERATIONS, A TAILBOARD SAFETY BRIEF WILL BE CONDUCTED.


- 1. TAILBOARD WILL BE CONDUCTED AT THE LANDING ZONE
- THE AIRCRAFT WILL LAND AT THE STAGING AREA TO CONNECT THE LONGLINE AND CONDUCT FUELING NORTH SIDE OF THE BUILDING
- 3. WATER TRUCK NOT REQUIRED
- 4. EQUIPMENT WILL BE STAGED IN THE STAGING AREA NORTH AND TO THE SOUTH OF THE BUILDING
- 5. EMERGENCY LANDING ZONE IS AT THE STAGING AREA AND ALONG THE FLIGHT PATH
- 6. PILOT AND GROUND CREW WILL BE IN RADIO COMMUNICATIONS
- 7. SUBJECT BUILDING WILL BE VACANT DURING OPERATIONS.
- 8. ALL ACCESS TO THE AMAZON CENTER TO THE OPERATIONS AREA WILL BE SECURED
- 9. GATES WILL BE CLOSED TO THE FACILITY
- 10. THE HELICOPTER WILL LAND AT THE STAGING AREA TO CONDUCT SAFETY BRIEF. ONCE THE UNITS ARE RIGGED AND EVERYONE IS IN PLACE THE PILOT WILL START THE OPERATION. THE UNITS WILL BE PLACED IN THE STAGING AREA IN A SEQUENTIAL ORDER. UNITS WILL BE STAGED ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE BUILDING. THE PILOT WILL LAND FOR FUEL AS NEEDED.




