


DURING THE LIFT EVOLUTION THE AIRCRAFT AND GROUND CREW WILL ALL BE IN RADIO COMMUNICATIONS. IN THE EVENT OF LOSS COMMUNICATIONS THE CREW WILL USE STANDARD HAND SIGNALS TO COMMUNICATE WITH THE PILOT. WHEN THE PILOT IS CLEAR HE WILL MOVE THE AIRCRAFT TO A SAFE LOCATION TO ALLOW THE COMMUNICATION PROBLEM TO BE RECTIFIED.

THE OPERATIONS AREA IS WITHIN THE SECURED AREA. ALL ESSENTIAL CREW WITHIN THE OPERATIONS AREA WILL NOT BE INVOLVED IN TAKING PICTURES OR ANY OTHER USE OF CELL PHONES.

A TAILBOARD SAFETY MEETING WILL BE HELD AT THE ASSIGNED AREA PRIOR TO BEGINNING HELICOPTER OPERATIONS

- 1. HELICOPTER WILL LAND AT THE LANDING ZONE TO CONNECT LONGLINE AND TO CONDUCT A TAILBOARD SAFETY BRIEF
- 2. WATER TRUCK IS REQUIRED NOT REQUIRED LZ APPROVED CONCRETE HELIPAD
- 3. FUELING WILL BE CONDUCTED AT THE LZ ONLY
- 4. ONCE LINE CREW IS READY THE STREET CLOSURE AND GHI GROUND CREW WILL KNOCK ON THE DOORS OF THE HOME TO BE EVACUATION. ONCE VERIFIED CLEAR OPERATIONS WILL BEGIN
- 5. RADIOS WILL BE GIVEN TO EACH CREW TO ENSURE COMMS WITH THE PILOT
- 6. THE NEW POLES WILL BE FLOWN FROM THE LZ TO THE POLE SITES MAINTAINING 500 FT FROM ANY DWELLING. ONCE THE NEW POLES ARE SET AND THE LINEMAN ARE READY THE HELICOPTER WILL PULL THE OLD POLES AND FLY THEM BACK TO THE LZ STAGING AREA
- 7. EMERGENCY LANDING ZONE IS AT THE STAGING AREA AND ALONG THE FLIGHT PATH
- 8. 4 ADDRESSES WILL BE VACANT. ALL BUILDINGS WITHIN THE OPERATING AREA WILL BE CLEAR
- 9. REMOTE ROADS WILL BE CLOSED WITH A FLAGMAN
- 10. TREE TRIMMING MAYBE REQUIRED PRIOR TO OPERATIONS


The timeframe for the evacuation is approximately 120 minutes once all residents have left.




DURING THE LIFT EVOLUTION THE AIRCRAFT AND GROUND CREW WILL ALL BE IN RADIO COMMUNICATIONS. IN THE EVENT OF LOSS COMMUNICATIONS THE CREW WILL USE STANDARD HAND SIGNALS TO COMMUNICATE WITH THE PILOT.
