

ONLY PERSONNEL PARTICIPATING IN THE SAFETY BRIEF WILL BE PERMITTED TO BE IN THE AREA OF OPERATIONS. ONLY AUTHORIZED ESSENTIAL PERSONAL WILL BE PERMITTED IN THE IMMEDIATE AREA OF OPERATIONS. IN THE EVENT AN UNAUTHORIZED PERSON ENTERS THE OPERATIONS AREA OR A POTENTIAL HAZARD IS IDENTIFIED THE PILOT WILL HOLD THE AIRCRAFT IN RELATIVE POSITION. THIS WILL BE ACHIEVED WITHOUT OVER FLYING THE GROUND CREW. ALL OPERATIONS WILL BE CEASED UNTIL THE PROBLEM IS RECTIFIED. IN THE EVENT OF AN AIRCRAFT EMERGENCY, THE PILOT WILL RADIO GROUND PERSONNEL AND WILL ATTEMPT TO LAND IN THE EMERGENCY LANDING AREA.

DURING THE LIFT EVOLUTION THE AIRCRAFT AND GROUND CREW WILL ALL BE IN RADIO COMMUNICATIONS. IN THE EVENT OF LOSS COMMUNICATIONS, THE CREW WILL USE STANDARD HAND SIGNALS TO COMMUNICATE WITH THE PILOT. WHEN THE PILOT IS CLEAR HE WILL MOVE THE AIRCRAFT TO A SAFE LOCATION TO ALLOW THE COMMUNICATION PROBLEM TO BE RECTIFIED.

THE OPERATIONS AREA IS WITHIN THE SECURED AREA. ALL ESSENTIAL CREW WITHIN THE OPERATIONS AREA WILL NOT BE INVOLVED IN TAKING PICTURES OR ANY OTHER USE OF CELL PHONES.

### PRIOR TO BEGINNING OPERATIONS, A TAILBOARD SAFETY BRIEF WILL BE CONDUCTED.

- 1. HELICOPTER WILL LAND AT THE LANDING ZONE TO CONDUCT TAILBOARD.
- 2. PARKING LOT NEAR STRUCTURE WILL BE VACANT FOR AN EMERGENCY LZ
- 3. TAILBOARD WILL BE CONDUCTED AT POLE STAGING AREA
- 4. WATER TRUCK IS REQUIRED AT LANDING AREAS
- 5. NO EVACUATIONS
- 6. STREET CLOSURE AT LZ AND AT STRUCTURE
- 7. TREE TRIMMING IF REQUIRED
