ATTEMPT TO LAND IN THE EMERGENCY LANDING AREA.

DURING THE LIFT EVOLUTION THE AIRCRAFT AND GROUND CREW WILL ALL BE IN RADIO COMMUNICATIONS. IN
THE EVENT OF LOSS COMMUNICATIONS, THE CREW WILL USE STANDARD HAND SIGNALS TO COMMUNICATE
WITH THE PILOT. WHEN THE PILOT IS CLEAR HE WILL MOVE THE AIRCRAFT TO A SAFE LOCATION TO ALLOW THE
COMMUNICATION PROBLEM TO BE RECTIFIED.

THE OPERATIONS AREA IS WITHIN THE SECURED AREA. ALL ESSENTIAL CREW WITHIN THE OPERATIONS AREA WILL NOT BE INVOLVED IN TAKING PICTURES OR ANY OTHER USE OF CELL PHONES.




