
DURING THE LIFT EVOLUTION THE AIRCRAFT AND GROUND CREW WILL ALL BE IN RADIO COMMUNICATIONS. IN THE EVENT OF LOSS COMMUNICATIONS THE CREW WILL USE STANDARD HAND SIGNALS TO COMMUNICATE WITH THE PILOT. WHEN THE PILOT IS CLEAR HE WILL MOVE THE AIRCRAFT TO A SAFE LOCATION TO ALLOW THE COMMUNICATION PROBLEM TO BE RECTIFIED.

THE OPERATIONS AREA IS WITHIN THE SECURED AREA. ALL ESSENTIAL CREW WITHIN THE OPERATIONS AREA WILL NOT BE INVOLVED IN TAKING PICTURES OR ANY OTHER USE OF CELL PHONES.

THE LANDING AND EMERGENCY LANDING AREA IS IN THE PARKING LOT TO THE SOUTH OF DICKS SPORTING GOODS. THE HELICOPTER WILL LAND IN THE LZ TO HOOK UP THE LONG LINE. ALL BUILDINGS IN THE OPERATING AREA WILL BE VACANT

Guardian helicopters Inc will be removing one unit and setting one unit on the NORTHRIDGE FASHION CENTER. Operations will take approximately 30 minutes and the building and parking lot will need to be vacant during the operation.

GHI ground crew will arrive at around 0630 to ensure the area is clear and to rig the units. The helicopter will land as close to 0730 as sunrise allows. Once we have completed at Tailboard safety brief the ground crew will verify the required portion of the mall is vacant and that all security is in place. The parties expressly agree that this Agreement contemplates, among other obligations, full indemnity if liability is imposed against any of the Indemnitees without their negligence and solely by reason of statute, operation of law or otherwise.
